The Catholic Daughters, St. Patrick Church and St. Patrick School are collecting non-perishable for food items for our Christmas food baskets. Due to the current restrictions, we cannot leave items in the church like we have in past years. The Catholic Daughters will offer a drive-thru drop service at the cafeteria on Saturday, December 5 from 9:00 to 11:00 a.m. and 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. and on Sunday, December 6 between the morning and the Latin Masses. This way you don't need to get out of your car. Someone will come to you and carry the food into the school. You may also leave items in the tote on the back porch of the parish office. Items needed include instant potatoes and gravy, cake/ brownie mix and icing, soup and crackers, mac and cheese and boxed dinners, peanut butter and jelly, pasta and sauce,

and canned goods.

These baskets are for people recommended through parishioners of St. Patrick Church and school. We work in conjunction with "Our Neighbor" to eliminate duplicates so we can help more people.

Commentary for the Readings in the Extraordinary Form: First Sunday of Advent

"There will be signs in the . . . (heavens). . . and upon the earth, distress of nations. . . they will see the Son of Man coming. . . lift up your heads, because your redemption is at hand" (Gospel).

On His second Advent at the end of the world Jesus will come in the fullness of Divine Power. Then will we be obliged to accept Him as King of Justice. So today let us begin to prepare for this year's anniversary of His first Advent as King of Mercy.

Because His coming is "nearer" we are warned to "rise from sleep, . . . lay aside the works of darkness. . . and put on he Lord Jesus Christ" (Epistle).

Aware of the dangers ahead during this preparation, we call upon His "power" to protect us (Prayer) and to "cleanse us" (Secret). Finally, we promise to "prepare with due reverence for the coming festival" (Postcommunion).



Parish Membership & Benefits:

To be considered an "active" member of any parish (and thus eligible for Sacraments, sponsor eligibility, and the "Active Parishioner Rate of tuition" at a Catholic school), the parish takes into account the following things. First, to receive a discount at a Catholic School or to receive a sacrament, the children MUST attend weekend Mass. Second, family & individual involvement in parish life and ministries are taken into consideration. Mass attendance is only able to be tracked accurately via collection envelopes. If you are not receiving envelopes currently, please contact the appropriate person at your parish.
