St. Patrick's Catholic School Hope Scholarship Q&A

What is the Hope Scholarship?

The Hope Scholarship Program is an education savings account (ESA) program that will allow parents and families to utilize the state portion of their education funding to tailor an individualized learning experience that works best for them.

How much is the Hope Scholarship?

The amount is based on the School Aid Formula which can vary from year to year. Each eligible student will receive \$4,600 for the 2022-2023 school year.

Who is eligible for the Hope Scholarship?

A student is eligible for the Hope Scholarship Program if they are a resident of West Virginia and are enrolling in kindergarten through eighth grade at a private institution for the first time. At the time of application, the student must be enrolled in a public school for at least 45 days during an instructional term.

When can I apply for the Hope Scholarship?

Currently, applications can be made through the WV State Treasurers Office and they will be made available no later than March 1, 2022. The Treasurer's Office will advertise the availability of applications at the appropriate time. Visit www.hopescholarshipwv.com for more information

Can I use the Hope Scholarship at St. Patrick's School?

Yes! Students who receive the Hope Scholarship may use it towards tuition and fees. The amount of the Hope Scholarship will cover 100% of tuition expenses at St. Patrick's School.

Why Can't Non-Catholics Receive Holy Communion?

Because Catholics believe that the celebration of the Eucharist is (but are not limited to) being married outside the church, being a sign of the reality of the oneness of faith, life, and worship, unmarried but living together or purposely not attending Sunday members of those churches with whom we are not yet fully united

For those who cannot receive Eucharist at this time, we welcome you to join in our liturgy, to pray and sing with us. Please If you have not observed the Eucharistic Fast one hour before remain in the pew during the Communion Procession, offering your heartfelt prayers to our God of love and mercy. We eagerly await the time when you will join us at the Eucharistic table!

Parish Membership & Benefits:

To be considered an "active" member of any parish (and thus eligible for Sacraments, sponsor eligibility, and the "Active Parishioner Rate of tuition" at a Catholic school), the parish takes into account the following things. First, to receive a discount at a Catholic School or to receive a sacrament, the children MUST attend weekend Mass. Second, family & individual involvement in parish life and ministries are taken into consideration. Mass attendance is only able to be tracked accurately via collection envelopes. If you are not receiving envelopes currently, please contact the parish office. Parishioners over 18 should register as a household to help us keep records accurate and up-to-date.

DANGEROUS APPS



TikTok is a popular app to create and share videos. It is often used for bullying and explicit content.



Zoomerang is a video creating app. Users often share their location and online predators can see where children are.



Whatsapp allows users to send texts, videos, photos, and to share thier location to their contacts.



YouTube is a video sharing app and website. Without restrictions set, many teens are exposed to violent or inappropriate videos.



Instagram allows users to share photos, video, and their location. Teens are often exposed to explicit content.



LiveMe is an app to broadcast and watch live-streaming videos. Users can share their geolocation through the app.



Ask.fm encourages users to allow anonymous people to ask them questions. It is often used for bullying and harassment.



Tumblr is for adults but is often used by teens to share photos and videos. Users can access adult content and profiles are often public.



Monkey is an app to live video chat with strangers. It also utilizes group chats and private message options.



Grinder is a dating app used mostly by the LGBTQ+ community. It allows chatting, photo sharing, and GPS location to be shared.





















Whisper encourages users to send messages or confessions which others comment on. This can lead to cyberbullying. Users can also share their location.

Snapchat allows users to share photos and short videos that delete after viewed. This app is often used to share explicit content and for cyberbullying.

Holla claims to be an "addicting" video chat app used to meet people from around the world. Explicit content is often encountered.

Tinder is a dating app for adults but widely used by teens with fake profiles. Teens are often exposed to explicit content and encouraged to meet up.

Zoosk is a dating app where users can find people based on location. It also uses a feature to match users with random people.

MeetMe is a dating app that uses location-based technology to connect users. The app encourages users to meet in person.

Skout is a location-based dating app. It does restrict users under 17 from sharing photos, but many kids use fake birthdays or create fake accounts.

Badoo is used for social networking and dating. The users can chat, share pictures and videos, and connect based on their locations.

IMVU is a virtual world for users to interact with others. There are areas where nudity and sexual encounters happen. The Chat Now pairs users randomly to chat.

Hot or Not is designed for users to rate your profile. You can also use the location service to find others nearby.

Plenty of Fish is a dating app that encourages chatting online with strangers. It allows location based profile browsing.



Kik is a messaging app that allows users to message others anonymously.



Best Secret Folder is a photo and video vault that uses passcode protection and decoy videos to hide inappropriate pictures.

Tellonym is an anonymous messaging app.Users are encouraged to ask questions anonymously which leads to many forms of cyberbullying.



Houseparty is for live video chatting. A user's friends and their friends can join the chat. Teens can be exposed to explicit content.


Hily is a dating app that allows users to chat or exchange photos/videos. Users can arrange meetings based on their GPS location.
