

When Should Catholics Not Receive Holy Communion?

- If you have a mortal sin on your soul. Some serious sins include (but are not limited to) being married outside the church, being unmarried but living together or purposely not attending Sunday Mass or holy days of obligation. For more info on what constitutes a mortal sin, refer to the Catechism of the Catholic Church 1857 - 1859.
- If you have not observed the Eucharistic Fast one hour before receiving. Mints and gum break your fast.If you have not yet received First Communion.

Why Can't Non-Catholics Receive Holy Communion?

Because Catholics believe that the celebration of the Eucharist is a sign of the reality of the oneness of faith, life, and worship, members of those churches with whom we are not yet fully united are not admitted to Holy Communion.

For those who cannot receive Eucharist at this time, we welcome you to join in our liturgy, to pray and sing with us. Please remain in the pew during the Communion Procession, offering your heartfelt prayers to our God of love and mercy. We eagerly await the time when you will join us at the Eucharistic table!

Safe Environment/VIRTUS

The word virtus derives from Latin, and means valor, moral strength, excellence, and worth. In ancient times, virtus denoted a way of life and manner of behavior that always aspired to the highest, most positive attributes of people and aspects of human interaction.

The Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston takes seriously this 'VIRTUS' pursuit of excellence in our community. We are committed to making every environment – a safe environment. All employees and volunteers are required to complete VIRTUS Training. Previously, anyone volunteering or working at a Catholic church or school who worked directly with children were the only ones required to have this training. However, last year, our diocese updated the list of those required to have the training to include those who are active in parish ministries and other activities such as readers, choir/handbell members, funeral dinner volunteers, etc. Participants of this training complete a background check, answer questions and watch short video modules to learn how to best protect the vulnerable in our community. This program is done to empower participants to accurately identify and correctly report all instances of suspected child abuse.

Every year, the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston – as well as all other Dioceses in the United States – is audited by the USCCB's independent agency for compliance with its Safe Environment mandate. The Diocese undergoes a data collection audit every year and an on-site audit every three years as part of the USCCB process. The Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston also engages Monaca, Pennsylvania-based CSI, an independent organization comprised of experienced professionals from law-enforcement, public safety, academia, and the private sector, who specialize in various services focused upon safety. At the Diocese's request and as an added layer of accountability, CSI representatives also conduct audits and spot checks to ensure compliance, accuracy, and consistency at the local level as well as fingerprinting for clergy and schools.

We thank all of the employees and volunteers for their continued support in making the environment at St. Patrick Church safe for all.

Go to http://www.virtusonline.org

On the left side of the screen, click on First-Time Registrant to begin registration. To proceed, click on Begin the registration process.

Select the name of your organization Wheeling-Charleston - Diocese (from the pull-down menu, by clicking the downward arrow and highlighting your organization). Once your organization is highlighted, click Select.

Create a User ID and Password you can easily remember.

This is necessary for all participants. This establishes your account with the VIRTUS program. If your preferred User ID is already taken, please choose another ID. We suggest the use of email addresses as usernames. Click Continue to proceed.

Provide all the information requested on the screen.

Several fields are required, including: First & Last Name, Email Address, Home Address, City, State, Zip, Phone Number, Date of Birth, and any Additional Names. (Note: Do not click the back button or your registration will be lost.) Click Continue to proceed.

Select the PRIMARY location where you work or volunteer by clicking the downward arrow and highlighting the location.

For school affiliation, select: St. Patrick School (Weston), For church affiliation, select: St. Patrick Parish (Weston) Click Continue to proceed.
