In the Parable of the Pharisee and the Tax Collector, Jesus offers a profound lesson on humility and true righteousness. Two men enter the temple to pray: one, a Pharisee, stands with pride, boasting of his religious observance and looking down on others. The other, a humble tax collector, stands at a distance, beating his breast and begging for God's mercy.

Jesus highlights the stark contrast between these two attitudes. The Pharisee's prayer is filled with self-righteousness, as he recites his virtues and compares himself to others. Conversely, the tax collector acknowledges his sinfulness and expresses genuine repentance, pleading, "O God, be merciful to me a sinner."

The shocking conclusion of the parable is that the tax collector, not the Pharisee, returns home justified before God. This teaches us that justification does not come from our own merits or prideful comparisons but from a contrite heart open to God's grace. Jesus reminds us that "everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted." True righteousness begins with humility, recognizing OUL dependence on God's mercy.

As we reflect on this parable, let's examine our own attitudes in prayer and daily life. Are we quick to compare ourselves to others, or do we approach God with sincere humility? Let's ask for the grace to cultivate a humble heart, always open to His forgiveness and love.
